Fluorspar market scene-setter Influencing factors

- Production capacity "lost" in recent years
- China:
 - reduction in capacity
 - reduction in high quality resources
 - growing domestic demand markets
 - increased imports
- Recent new sources not fully operational
- Risks of overreliance on China as primary source
- Development of new fluorspar and alternative F sources
- 2020-21: COVID-19 impact on supply/markets
- Fluorspar classified as strategic/critical mineral
 - potential demand growth in new energy sources?
- US HFC Phase Down approaches; EC F-gas review



Fluorosilicic acid (FSA)

- Waste stream from phosacid production
- Much debated
- Wengfu Group, China

Nutrien to supply Arkema with 40k tpa anhydrous HF from phosphate rock processing FSA waste











Shape of things to come? Nutrien's huge Aurora, NC phosphate mine (1) produced 4.3m tonnes phosrock in 2019, supplying its processing complex (2) (prod. cap. 5.4m tpa phos. concentrate, 1.2m tpa phos acid, and 0.8m tpa DAP/MAP). By 2022 a new 40,000 tpa FSA-to-AHF plant will be installed (may look like 3) to supply Arkema's Calvert City, KY plant (4), producing fluoropolymers and fluorochemicals (5), replacing an equivalent approx. 88,000 tpa acid grade fluorspar input.
