






World fluorspar production 2020

Total: 7.6m tonnes (figs. below '000s tonnes)









World fluorspar trade 2020

Acidspar primary export sources




Acidspar primary import markets









World fluorspar trade 2020




Chinese fluorspar trade 2010-2020


Becoming a net importer





China acidspar exports decline 2010-2020








Mongolian metspar exports rise 2010-2020

Supply developments

- Canada Fluorspar Inc. (CFI): celebrated July 2021 1st fluorspar shipment from new terminal at Blue Beach, St. Lawrence Harbour; 17 metre draft permits access to more markets using larger ore carriers.
- Ares Strategic Mining Inc. (ASM): filed NI 43-101 compliant updated Technical Report on its Lost Sheep Mine Fluorspar Project, located near Delta, Utah; discovered new F-rich zone; acquired processing plant, under construction.
- Commerce Resources Corp.: initiated mineral processing programme to determine final Prefeasibility Study (PFS) design criteria of front-end flowsheet for Ashram Rare Earth and Fluorspar Deposit, Quebec, Canada
- Eclipse Metals Ltd: continuing examination of historical diamond drill core at lvittuut cryolite mine district, southwestern Greenland. lvittuut open pit mine was until 1987 world's largest producer of cryolite (Na3AlF6).
- ALCORE: progressing with its 10,000 tpa AIF₃ plant project in Australia, using AI smelter waste.
- Elixir Prahovo: new AIF3 producer in Serbia, started March 2021; 4,000t for 2021, targeting 10,000 tpa AIF3 in 2023; using FSA from captive 165k tpa phosacid plant.







Supply developments

- Gobishoo LLC, Mongolia
 - ramping up to serve Asian and European markets with acidspar and metspar grades
 - Shine Us mine and plant site in Dundgobi province
 - May 2020 Gobishoo commissioned 35,000 tpa acidspar plant
 - approx. 30m t fluorspar deposit using surface and underground mines; "current shelf" mined hosts 700,000 tonnes reserves, "leading to" 4.5-5.0m tonnes; ore grade 18-40% CaF₂.
 - 2,000 tpm acid grade powder; funding in place to increase output to 100,000 tpa acid grade.
 - Appointed Fluorspar Ltd, UK as exclusive sales agent







Market developments

- Raw material price rises: supply tightness, energy and logistics issues contributing factors leading to fluorspar and F product price increases, eg. domestic acidspar US\$400+/t, and R134a up >67% in September to US\$7,000/t.
- **Metallurgical markets:** riding high with increasing prices and buoyant demand forecasts into 2022, eg. steel demand to grow by 4.5% in 2021 and a further increase of 2.2% in 2022 to 1,896.4m tonnes;

HFC phase out ongoing:

- USA, India and China's recent ratification boosts Kigali Amendment to cut production and consumption of HFCs by >80% over next 30 years.
- o EU debate over REACH impact on HFC/HFOs; EC's F-gas review also sparked criticism.
- Ongoing development and certification of low GWP alternatives by manufacturers
- US EPA released proposed rulemaking to establish allocation system to decrease production and import of HFCs by 85% over next 15 years, effective 1 January 2022.
- China market growth: drive to expand fluorochemical sector, eg.
 - o 14th Five-Year Plan for High-End Development of Chemical Industry in Jiangsu Province to focus on fluorine materials
 - Mar. 2021 "World's largest fluorine chemical industry base" Inner Mongolia JV: Kings Resources, Inner Mongolia Bao
 Gang United Steel, Longda Food, & Zhejiang Yonghe Refrigerant
- **India market growth:** driven by automobile, air conditioning, refrigeration, construction cold storage, pharma/life science sectors. India expected to be world's 4th largest chemical producer by 2030.








Semiconductors

- increased demand as more use of IT devices for online interactions owing to pandemic
- 2021 shortage of high-purity electronic-grade HF for semiconductor production
- governments now sensitive to semiconductor supply chain, want to boost domestic manufacturing sectors

Li-ion battery market potential

- encouraging F product developments and capacity hikes, eg. June 2021 Arkema new Kynar[®] PVDF specifically targeted for LIB
- PVDF used as binder in production of electrodes and as separator coating
- Arkema to further increase fluoropolymer production capacity in Changshu, China by 35% in 2022; Solvay also increasing PVDF capacity in China for LIB


